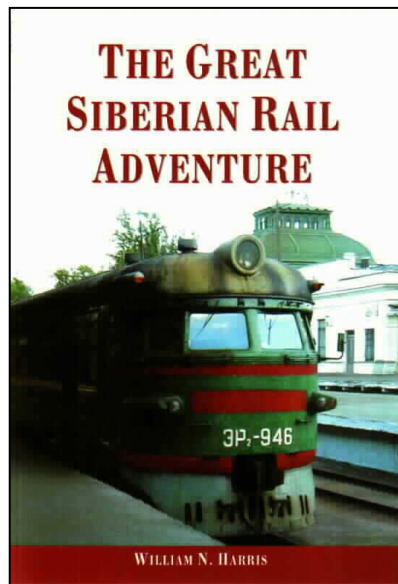


# *The Great Siberian Rail Adventure!*
